Purpose of the Policy

Use of the UUCWI name in public statements implies congregational approval. This has implications that transcend the particular issue at hand. Therefore, this policy lays out guidelines for such use and for acquiring BOT approval as necessary.

UUCWI Name Use Policy

- 1. The Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Whidbey Island will not endorse individual political candidates, nor take any action to jeopardize the tax-exempt status of the Congregation. This does not prevent individual members and friends from expressing their personal views.
- 2. Individual committees and UUCWI staff may speak for themselves on various issues, but must receive permission from the Board to speak for the Congregation. To request such permission, fill out the Name Use Application. The Board shall review all requests, and if the appropriateness or inappropriateness of the request is clear, then the Board shall act accordingly.
- 3. However, if the Board is unclear on the appropriateness of a particular use of the UUCWI name, it will refer to procedures outlined in the Policy on Endorsements and Resolutions.
