## Updated Covid Guidelines

The Covid 19 Task Force met to discuss relaxation of the moratorium placed in August on UUCWI campus activity. The following are the revised Covid 19 guidelines:

### Building Use:

1. A limit of up to five persons may gather in the church building on any given day. Only one such group will be allowed to gather indoors during any 24-hour period. Anyone entering and using the church will be expected to follow the previous guidelines of using a protective mask and distancing.
2. Scheduling through Stephanie Chia will continue to prevent overlap of activities.
3. All those gathering in the church must have on file with Stephanie a copy of their vaccine status.
  - Fully vaccinated status must include completion of two doses of Moderna or Pfizer vaccine plus two-weeks following last vaccination, one dose of Johnson/Johnson plus two-week waiting time.
  - It is now recommended that all eligible individuals have a booster of one of the above vaccines before participating in group activities.
4. All individuals entering the building are required to sign into the log in the foyer.
5. All individuals entering the building are required to follow the guidelines posted in the foyer concerning cleaning and sanitation while using the building.
6. A “Host” shall be designated by all groups to oversee the following information gathering: review of potential Covid symptoms with all group individuals.

### In the last 48 hours:

- Have you had any fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
- Have you had any headache, fatigue, sore throat, or loss of smell and/or taste?
- Have you had any nausea, vomiting or diarrhea?”
- Report any travel to foreign countries or areas of high infection in the US within the past two weeks.
- Any known or suspected exposure to a Covid infected individual.
- Report immediately the development of any verified Covid infection within a two-week span of having used the building.

### Use of campus grounds:

During this time, we are requesting that individuals gathering out of doors on the campus do so with protective face masks and the recommended “physical distancing” of six feet. Use of the bathroom will be limited to one individual at a time unless part of a family unit where bathrooms are typically shared.
