These guidelines are based on the community level indicated for Island County on the Covid Act Now website. The guidelines will remain in effect during the green, low community level.

Mindful of our covenant which calls us to care for one another and recognizing that we have some members at high risk and others who would prefer to meet in person with no restrictions, the Board has developed these guidelines for the coming months. We will review and update them as conditions warrant. As always, we welcome your responses to them.

We will be fully vaccinated and boosted as allowed by age.

We will schedule indoor and outdoor gatherings including Sunday worship in advance through administration.

We will while indoors wear face masks if we are over the age of two.

We will respect the concerns of each person present and ask for consent before touching or hugging.

Campus & Facilities

- Prescheduled group indoor activities (up to 25 persons in the sanctuary) following current Covid Guidelines.
- Restrooms open.

Worship

- Multi-platform
- Minister/speaker, Worship Associates and Tech all masked except during active speaking or solo singing by designated speaker/singer.
- 25 prescheduled congregants in sanctuary.
- Outside Services: as arranged by Worship Committee.
- Information on how to register for a service will be posted in the eNews.

Music

- Woodwinds and brass instruments allowed when using special masks for these instruments.
- Masked singing by congregation allowed.

Food

- Outdoor food/drink served by limited kitchen team of 3 masked individuals.
- For larger group events special arrangements to be made through administration. Encourage outdoor eating.
