- *We will measure not only our own known risk but also the potential risk for others in the congregation.*
- *We will respect the concerns of each person present and ask for consent before touching or hugging.*
- *We will schedule indoor and outdoor gatherings including Sunday worship in advance through administration.*

Campus & Facilities

- Open – no limit.

Worship

- Multi-platform
- Masks are recommended but not required
- Unlimited participation.

Music

- Woodwinds and brass instruments allowed
- Singing by congregation allowed.

Food

- Indoor Coffee Hour
- Kitchen limited to those involved in food preparation.
- Water fountains available.
